**Dr. Henri Pallard, Ph.D.**



**Dr. Henri Pallard**

Dr. Henri Pallard is the Director, International Center for Interdisciplinary Research in Law (ICIRL), and Professor, Department of Law and Justice, Laurentian University, Sudbury (Ontario), Canada. He is broadly interested in the relationship between culture and human rights as it manifests itself in both western and non western cultures. Dr. Pallard is particularly interested in the challenges faced by the Arab world in its efforts to reconcile politics and religion.

From 1994 to 2004, he was the Director of Persons, Culture and Rights (Personne, culture et droits), an international North/South research team which was funded by the International Francophone University (Agence universitaire de la Francophonie).

During this period, they worked closely with researchers and academics from Morocco, Tunisia and Egypt distilling the cultural issues underlying the interpretation and implementation of human rights, the rule of law and democracy in North Africa.

He is currently the Associate Director, Poverty, Homelessness and Migration, at Laurentian University, a \$1 million project funded by the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada (SSHRC). Working in partnership with First Nations and northern communities, this five-year project examines the underlying causes of poverty, poor housing, homelessness, and out-migration in northern Ontario to gain knowledge on these issues, understand their impact on northern Ontario, and give communities the tools they need to ensure that the most basic human needs of their citizens are met.

In 2008, Dr. Henri Pallard was awarded the Laurentian University Research Excellence Award in recognition of his work internationally which contributed significantly to the reputation and prestige of the university. In 2010 he was the recipient of the 2010 Saint-Jean Award of Merit for Distinguished Alumni. This award is the most prestigious honour that the Saint-Jean Campus, University of Alberta, bestows upon one alumnus each year in recognition for demonstrating leadership in her/his profession. In 1992, he was awarded a research fellowship from the International Francophone University and spent a year at the Centre de philosophie du droit, Université Paris II.

Dr. Pallard received his PhD in Philosophy of law from the University of Nice (France), summa cum laude, on the France-Canada cultural exchange programme (1976-1981). He then obtained his law degree (LL.B.) from McGill University (1984). He is also a member of the Ontario Bar, Canada.

**Dr. Chowdhury** is a Professor and former Chairman of the Department of Geography and Environmental Studies, University of Chittagong (UC), Bangladesh (2002 – 2005). He received B.Sc. (Honours) and M.Sc. Degrees in Geography from the University of Dhaka in 1977 and 1978 respectively. He obtained his M.A. and Ph.D. Degrees in Geography from the University of Western Ontario (UWO), London, Canada in 1984 and 1988 respectively. His Doctoral research on “Dimensions of Development and Change in Bangladesh” was financially supported by the International Development Research Centre (IDRC, Ottawa- a prestigious scientific crown corporation of the Canadian Parliament) under its ‘Energy Award’-1985 Program. In 1999, he was elected Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society (FRGS) with the Institute of British Geographers (IBG), London, U.K

Dr Chowdhury has wide travel experience in Asia, Europe and North America, and held academic positions at the University of Western Ontario, London, Canada; Ryerson University, Toronto, Canada, UN-ESCAP CAPSA, Bogor, Indonesia and Southern University Bangladesh (SUB), Chittagong. He is a member of the Academic Council of UC and SUB. He also has been serving as a member of the Editorial Board- Subject Editor of The Chittagong University Journal of Biological Sciences (2008- Present), and a Guest Reviewer of the Springer’s Journal of Environment, Development and Sustainability. In the past (2003-2006, he worked for the Chittagong University Journal of Science in a similar capacity. Dr. Chowdhury’s many awards and scholarships include IDRC Energy Award, International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA, Vienna) Scholarship/ University of Hohenheim (Stuttgart, Germany), University of Western Ontario Scholarship (1981-1988) and Dhaka University Post-Graduate Merit Scholarship. Prior to joining the University of Chittagong (2002), Dr. Chowdhury worked in Indonesia for four years (1998-2001) under a prescribed development/technical assistance program of the Government of Canada i.e. program funded by the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA). As part of the program, he served the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UN-ESCAP, Bangkok, Thailand) as a long-term consultant in their agro-economic advisory field. He also worked for the UN-ESCAP Regional Coordination Centre for Research and Development of Coarse Grains, Pulses, Roots and Tuber (CGPRT) Crops in the Humid Tropics of Asia and the Pacific (now Centre for Alleviation Poverty through Sustainable Agriculture/CAPSA, based in Bogor, Indonesia) as Agricultural Economic Training Specialist. Of the major achievements, he conducted five regional training courses/ workshops including two in-country courses in the Philippines (jointly organized by the Philippine Council for Agriculture, Forestry and Natural Resources Research and Development/PCARD, Los Banos) and Sri Lanka (jointly organized by the Sri Lankan Department of Agriculture). He is an active contributor to the Sustainable Agriculture Technology Network Asia (SATNET Asia), managed by the UN-ESCAP CAPSA. Professionally, he is well connected to the International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development (ICIMOD) Kathmandu, Nepal through the Himalayan University Consortium (HUC); Food Security Centre (FSC) and the Institute of Biological Sciences and Nutrition, University of Hohenheim, Stuttgart, Germany.

Dr. Carol Kauppi is the Director of the Centre for Research in Social Justice and Policy and a Professor of Social Work at Laurentian University. Carol is also the Director of a multi-year, multi-methods research project, *Poverty, Homelessness and Migration in Northern Ontario*, a Community-University Research Alliance funded by the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada. Between 2010 and 2016, Poverty, Homelessness and Migration conducted 62 studies of homelessness. Carol is the lead author on the report entitled *Homelessness and Hidden Homelessness in Rural and Northern Ontario*, a province-wide study completed in 2017. She is also the author of the Ontario document *Period Prevalence Counts of People Experiencing Homelessness: A Guide for Rural and Northern Communities* published by the Ministry of Housing in 2017. She is also an editor of *Place, Space, Poverty and Homelessness in Northeastern Ontario, Canada*, OIDA International Journal of Sustainable Development. 8(4) (Special issue). She is currently working with a team of researchers and the North East Local Health Integration Network on a project examining palliative care needs of people living with homelessness in northeastern Ontario.

In addition to a focus on homelessness, her research interests in recent years have included girlhood, adolescence, and motherhood in northern communities. She has published many articles and reports dealing with homelessness and housing, racism, family issues, young mothers, parenting, postpartum depression, and child and family poverty in Sudbury and northern Ontario. Between 2003 and 2008, she completed a multi-year, province-wide and national project on girlhood. As part of this project she co-edited and published an anthology of girls' creative writing and art, *girlSpoken: from pen, brush and tongue*, as well as a facilitator's guide for teachers and service providers. The *girlSpoken* book has received an award from the Amelia Bloomer Project which is sponsored by the Feminist Task Force of the Social Responsibilities Round Table of the American Library Association. In 2011, she received the Research Excellence Award from Laurentian University, Canada.
